



In Buddhism, living beings are subject to reincarnation as regulated by the Law of Karma. This means that they can reborn into different forms depending on their good deeds and misdeeds. In general, living beings who commit good deeds will be reborn in the wholesome realms such as the celestial world and human world. By contrast, living beings who commit more bad than good deeds are more likely to be reborn into unwholesome realms such as hell or the animal and Peta realms.

A Peta is a hungry ghost who suffers from various forms of punishment depending on its karma. However, the punishment endured by a Peta can be considered less fatal than those who are reborn in the realm of hell. The fatality of their punishment depends on the severity of misdeeds they committed when they were living beings.

Although Peta cannot be seen with physical eyes some people cxn occasionally see them by chance. However, with their power of insight vision advanced meditation practitioner can see them clearly.

This book is published with the aim of discouraging its readers from doing misdeeds during their lifetime as these will cause suffering both in the present and the future. Thus, the truth about Peta awaits your own discovery, either through meditation or by direct experience after passing away.

The Hungry Ghosts Who Suffer from Their Own Misdeeds

A Peta was previously a human or angel who was once sinful. Such persons had already redeemed most of their sins in the realm of hell previously. However, some of their sin remained causing them to become a Peta who endured extreme torture and a lifetime of a million years. There are many types of Peta, each is classified by its sins. A Peta's life can only end with the help of donated merits or by completely redeeming its sins.





PETA Eating its Baby

This Peta became pregnant sinfully, and will eat its baby after delivery. This results from it being jealous and poisoning a mistress until she aborted.

A Skeleton PETA

This type of Peta has no flesh; all that remains is a skeleton. The Peta has to suffer and cries painfully all the time. Its punishment results from the sin of killing animals and slicing up their meat until only the skeleton remained.

PETA with Nails of Spears and Swords

This Peta has very sharp nails, which it uses as claws to eat its own flesh all the time. This Peta once lived a life of causing pain to others. Its sin is from killing animals for food.

PETA Scooping up Chaff with its Hannds

This Peta uses its hands to scoop up burning chaff and place on its head. It has to painfully suffer such burning because it was once a merchant who used to cheat its customers by mixing laterite with wheat in order to increase the weight when selling.

PETA suffering from Raining Hammers

The head of this Peta is badly wounded by 60,000 raining hammers from the sky. When its head appears again, the raining hammers beat it again and again for a very long time. This is because it once threw pebbles at a Buddhist monk while he was seeking alms. As a consequence, the monk passed away.

Grilled PETA

This Peta is being burnt alive with red hot coals. This is because it once set fire to another person and burnt their entire body.

PETA with the Head Located on the Lumbar Portion of its Spine

The head of this Peta is located on the lumbar portion of its spine enabling it to extend its tongue so that it can consume its own excrement. Moreover, the Peta's body is riddled with worms causing extreme suffering. This results from it once being dishonest by cheating and also accepting bribery.



Half of this Peta's body is sunk into the ground. Only the upper part of the body appears above ground thus the Peta is unable to escape. Furthermore, it is burnt all the time, which is the result of it once invading a temple and moving a boundary post without permission. The Peta was trying to cheat the temple out of its land.

Vomiting and Eating PETA

This kind of Peta is tall and dark, with a swollen stomach. It vomits worms and excrement, which it them gathers to be eaten again. This is because it once broke the Buddhist Precepts by stealing, lying and drinking alcohol.

When someone spits, this Peta always secretly eats their saliva and never lets them see its body. This is because it once entered a temple and spat upon the ground.

PETA Carrying Garbage over its Head

This Peta carries smelly garbage all the time. This is because it was once an abbot who was selfishly possessive about his residence. He refused even to give a one-night's stay to a passing monk

Armless and On-fire PETA

This Peta endures a lot of suffering. This is because it once cheated and stole the treasures of other people.



The eyes of this Peta protrude and are very ugly. The eyes are full of worms all the time. This is because it once used its eyes sinfully and immorally.

PETA in the Body of Chicken with the Face of Pig

This Peta has an ugly and scary body. Its body looks like a chicken while its face appears like a pig. This kind of Peta is significantly more unwell than other kinds of Peta. It does not dare to be seen by anyone because it is ashamed of its body. This is because it usually killed pigs and chicken

This Peta hits its head with a hammer all the time. It cannot stop this and has to endure a lot of suffering. This is because it once brought friends to its home but its mother did not welcome the friends. Therefore, it angrily hit its mother's head with a leather rope.



The body of this Peta has sharp spears protruding from its pores and is also on fire. This is because it was once a hunter who hunted animals with spears.



This Peta has a humanbody but the arms, legs and head of a monkey. This is because it once liked mocking grandparents, the elderly and the virtuous persons.

This is because it once picked up a blown away flag which was used for worshipping a pagoda. However, instead of returning the flag, it happily hung the flag on its neck.

This Peta was once a millionaire who was possessive about his properties. One day he gave his child a present; a fan made of peacock's feathers. The child duly offered it to a monk. After finding out, the millionaire always regretted giving away the fan. When he died, he had to become a Peta. However, the merit his child made by offering the peacock-feather fan to the monk causes the Peta to have beautiful hair.

PETA Dragging its Penis

This Peta has a huge and very heavy penis, which is continuously on fire. This is because it used to speak a rude word for penis in front of virtuous people.



There are two Petas hitting each other with hammers until their bodies start to show abscesses. The two Petas then help each other remove the lymph, which they eat. The reason for this is because they were once a couple who did not pay respect to the Buddha, Dhamma and Sangha. When they saw a monk, they always cursed him with rude words.

Beautiful PETA

This Peta is as elegant as an angel. However, it always kneels and bends down while hungrily eating unhygienic substances such as mucus, saliva and phlegm. This is because it was once a monk who did not conform to the Buddhist precepts. Also, he did not intend to practice meditation. On the contrary, he persuaded other people to give up meditation.

PETA Eating Blood and Lymph

This Peta eats excrement and licks the lymph of another Peta queuing before it. The reason for this is because it was once a very selfish millionaire who persuaded other people to give up making merit.

PETA Removing its Intestines to Feed Metal-beaked Crows

This Peta has to suffer immensely by removing its own intestines to feed metal-beaked crows. The reason for this is because, when it was a human, it loved to disclose the secrets of other people in exchange for rewards.



The body of this Peta resembles a gigantic dog suffering from being on fire. This is because it used to use black magic and dislike monks. Therefore, it scolded the monks and compared them to dogs.

This Peta has a human body but its legs and head resemble a pig. Its tail appears from its mouth and its body is covered in worms and it is on fire constantly. The Peta also vomits excrement and the reason for this state is because it used to earne its living by killing pigs and selling them.

This Peta has a twisted neck, arms, hands, body and legs. This is because it once loved to distort the truth in order to earn money.

Pig's Head PETA with Fangs

This is a female Peta with a pig's head and fangs This is because it once liked scolding its husband and its husband's mother.

PETA full of Abscesses

The body of this Peta is covered in abscesses and flowing smelly lymph. When the abscess is ripe, metalbeaked crows come to suck the lymph. This is because it was once a medium or shaman.



This Peta suffers from black blood flowing constantly from its mouth. This is because when it was a child, it angrily scolded its mother who took its money to buy food alms for monks. Therefore, it cursed the monks so that they would have black blood coming from their mouths

PETA with Hair of Spears and Sword

This Peta has a very long tongue. At the end of it there is a knife which it uses as a whip to cut itself. There are spears and swords appearing up and down from the pores to cause constant suffering all over its body. This is because it loved to scold at virtuous people when it was a human

PETA Eating its Own Flesh

This Peta discards its flesh until only the skeleton remains. It picks up its own flesh to eat. This is because it once liked deceiving other people and discouraging those who intended to make merit.

PETA with no Mouth

This Peta has no mouth. It carries a knife in its right hand and an ewer in its left hand. Inside of its body is full of worms who try to get out but there is no opening for them to exit. Thus, the Peta has to cut its mouth open in order for the worms to escape. Then the Peta pours acid in the ewer onto its wounds causing so much suffering. This is because it used to mock, insult and discourage people who made merit.

PETA with Large Hands and Feet

The ears of this Peta are under its chin. The Peta has large hands and feet but an extremely small mouth no bigger than the eye of a needle. This is because it always argued with and assaulted its parents when it was a human.

PETA with Burning Fire coming from its Mouth



Two PETAS Eating Excrement

There are two Petas; one is standing on the shoulders of the other. The upper Peta waits for the excrement of another Peta while the lower Peta waits for the excrement of the one above it. This is because the lower Peta was once an abbot who was very selfish and jealous. He scolded a particular monk who visited his patron's house because he did not want the monk to receive offerings. He also accused the monk to the patron who believed in his words. After they passed away, the patron became the upper Peta while the abbot became the lower one.

This Peta has a human body but its head, arms and legs resemble a mouse. This is because it was once rich but also very selfish. It tried to hide the fact that it had a lot of properties. When it nearly died, its mind still clung to its properties.
